Under FIFA rules someone is allowed to play for a country's football team if they were born there, their parents or grandparents were born there, or if they have lived there for 5 years.



Someone with no previous family connection to Britain who moved to Britain as an adult and took British citizenship would not be allowed to play for any of the national teams.


Do you think people who have become British and have lived here for at least five years should or should not be eligible to play for the English, Scottish, Welsh or Northern Ireland football teams?
