Currently murder carries a mandatory life sentence in the UK, and judges set a minimum number of years that anyone found guilty of murder will serve before being eligible for parole. In setting minimum tariffs judges have to abide by various guidelines, such as a minimum of 25 years for knife murders, or 30 years for murdering a police officer.

Ken Clarke has suggested ending these minimum tariffs for types of murder. While all murderers would still receive a life sentence, judges would be given the freedom to decide what the appropriate minimum sentence served would be. David Cameron has ruled out this suggestion, insisting that minimum tariffs will still be set out in law but be made simpler to understand.
