During the 1980s many Western countries, including the UK, cut off normal diplomatic relations with Libya in response to their involvement in terrorism. Under the last Labour government Britain and other Western countries re-established positive relations with Libya in exchange for Colonel Gaddafi's regime agreeing to abandon its programme developing weapons of mass destruction. Libya also agreed to pay compensation to the victims of the Lockerbie bombing.
