Wikileaks, an independent website, has published 90,000 leaked military documents from the US army operation in Afghanistan. These included documents showing NATO concerns that Pakistan and Iran were helping the Taliban and details of Afghan civilians killed in US operations. The US has criticised the leak, claiming it threatens national security, while Wikileaks says the disclosure is in the public interest.

Currently victims of rape are granted anonymity before, during and after the trial of their attacker.

People who have been accused of rape are not given anonymity, and some people who have been accused of rape but found not guilty by a jury have said the accusation has nevertheless destroyed their reputation. It has been suggested that people accused of rape should have the same right to anonymity as their accuser

Critics of this idea have claimed that conviction rates for rape are already low, that publicity around rape trials often gives other victims the courage to come forward, and that anonymity was not given to people accused of other equally serious crimes.

The government had been expected to give those accused of rape a right to anonymity, but has now said it will instead work with organisations like the Press Complaints Commission to encourage the media not to identify people accused.
