

The TV debates: Sun / YouGov survey results

YouGov questioned 1,151 viewers of the TV debate among the party leaders immediately after the debate on April 29. The data were weighted to the profile of all viewers of the programme, as indicated by those telling YouGov in the initial screening survey that they were 'absolutely certain' to watch the first debate*
