## On another subject...

Transport for London recently introduced the Barclays Cycle Hire scheme, sometimes called 'Boris Bikes'. The scheme allows people to register to hire bikes across central London. Once registered, users take a bike, ride it where they like, then return it to special docking stations. The service operates 24 hours a day, all year round. It is self-service and there is no booking. The scheme is estimated to cost £140 million over six years with Barclays contributing £25 million in sponsorship.
