In 2014, Russian military forces took control of a neighbouring region called Crimea, which was then part of Ukraine. A referendum was then held in Crimea, in which a majority voted to separate from Ukraine and become part of Russia. Some questioned the legitimacy of the referendum and currently most countries in the world, including the United States and member-states of the European Union, do not recognise Russian control, or 'sovereignty', over Crimea.
