# **METHODOLOGY**

YouGov invited 10,028 U.S. adults to participate in 9 surveys. The surveys were fielded every 4 weeks between February 21 and October 22, 2024 for the SAY24 project for Stanford, Arizona State, and Yale Universities. Respondents were selected to be representative of the U.S. adult population. Between 4,730 and 6,813 respondents completed each survey.

Each sample was weighted according to gender, age, race, and education based on the U.S. Census American Community Survey, and the U.S. Census Current Population Survey, as well as 2020 Presidential vote and partisan identification. Weights for each survey range from 0.04 to 6.79, with a mean of 1 and standard deviations ranging from 1.1 to 1.5.

The margin of error for a percentage based upon the entire sample for each month ranges between  $\pm$  1.9 and  $\pm$  2.5 points. The margin of error is larger for subsamples and differences of percentages.
