## 8. Policy approval

Current US immigration law allows any Cuban citizen who makes it to the United States to remain in the country, and after one year the person may apply for permanent residence. However, if the Coast Guard intercepts a Cuban citizen at sea attempting to get into the US without appropriate documentation, the Coast Guard will not permit the person entry to the US. This is informally called the "Wet foot/Dry foot" policy.
