

1. Approval of peace deal

As part of an agreement between the United States and Russia, the Syrian government has agreed to reveal its full inventory of chemical weapons within a week, allow international inspectors to come to Syria by November and to give up all of its chemical weapons by mid-2014 in order to prevent U.S. military strikes.
