More lenient	28%

2. Do you think it will be possible to eliminate COVID-19 from some regions of the world while it continues to circulate in others?

Yes	36%
No	64%

3. Do you think the global COVID-19 case count will fall to zero or a negligible number in your lifetime?

Yes	44%
No	56%

4. If you had to say, which of the following do you think would make a better Supreme Court justice?

A former defense lawyer	28%
A former prosecutor	20%
Not sure	52%

5. Do you think that American adults are more or less misinformed now, in 2022, than they were 30 years ago, in 1992?

More misinformed now	51%
Less misinformed now	21%
