1. Do you think it should be legal to smoke marijuana?

Yes 45%
 No 39%
 Not sure 16%

2. Do you think the legislation has been a success or a failure in the states that have decided to allow marijuana use?

Success only 12%
 More of a success than a failure 32%
 More of a failure than a success 23%
 Failure only 13%
 Not sure 20%

3. Do you support or oppose a local proposal to legalize recreational marijuana use in the District of Columbia?

Support strongly 26%
 Support somewhat 17%
 Oppose somewhat 12%
 Oppose strongly 29%
 Not sure 15%

4. Because it is a federal enclave, Congress has direct oversight over affairs in the District of Columbia. If the voters in Washington, DC approve a local ordinance to legalize recreational marijuana use, do you think the Congress should or should not override the local law?

Congress should override local ordinance 29%
 Congress should not override local ordinance 49%
 Don't know 22%
