1. Do you think married couples should pay more or less in taxes than single tax payers?

Married couples should pay more 13%
 Married couples should pay the same as single tax payers 52%
 Married couples should pay less 20%
 Not sure 15%

2. Do you think there should or should not be a special tax break for married couples?

Should be a tax break 36%
 Should NOT be a tax break 44%
 Not sure 20%

3. Do you think it is or is not the government's business to encourage people to do certain things in their life, such as marry or have children?

It is 9%
 It is NOT 79%
 Not sure 12%

4. Do you think it is better to raise children in a home where the parents are married or unmarried?

Married parents 59%
 Unmarried parents 1%
 It doesn't make a difference 35%
 Not sure 5%

5. Do you think couples that are in a committed long term relationship should get married or does it not matter?

Should get married	44%
Doesn't matter	47%
Not sure	9%

6. Do you think that a tax break for married couples will have any impact on how many couples marry or get divorced?

Will have an impact	37%
Will NOT have an impact	38%
Not sure	25%
