Show feelings easily 39%

2. Do you think that politicians are generally too open with their emotions or too reserved?

3. Do you think that Barack Obama is too open with his emotions or too reserved?

4. Do you think it was acceptable or unacceptable for Barack Obama to shed tears as he talked about children killed in gun violence?

Interviewing Dates	January 5 - 7, 2016
Target population	U.S. adults, aged 18 and over.
Sampling method	Respondents were selected from YouGov's opt-in Internet panel using sample matching. A random sample (stratified by age, gender, race, education, and region) was selected from the 2010 American Community Study. Voter registration was imputed from the November 2010 Current Population Survey Registration and Voting Supplement. Religion, minor party identification, and non-placement on an ideology scale, were imputed from the 2008 Pew Religion in American Life Survey.
Weighting	The sample was weighted using propensity scores based on age, gender, race, education, voter registration, and non-placement on an ideology scale. The weights range from 0.152 to 4.121, with a mean of one and a standard deviation of 0.901.
